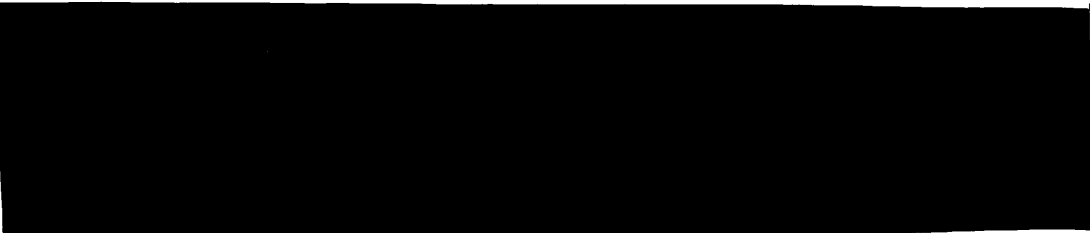

SUMMARY: ~~(S/NOFORN)~~ IN EARLY JANUARY 1995, THE SOMALI NATIONAL
ALLIANCE RECEIVED TWO AIRPLANE LOADS OF WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION
FROM IRAN. THE SHIPMENT, WHICH INCLUDED SHOULDER-FIRED
ANTI-AIRCRAFT WEAPONS, WAS FLOWN TO SOMALIA THROUGH SAUDI ARABIA.

2. ~~(S/NOFORN)~~ THE SHIPMENT FROM IRAN INCLUDED 23 SHOULDER-FIRED ANTI-AIRCRAFT WEAPONS OF AN UNKNOWN TYPE, 126 BOXES OF 7.62 MILLIMETER (MM) AK-47 ROUNDS, 126 BOXES OF 7.62 MM G-3 ROUNDS, AND 480 ROUNDS OF 106 MM M40 RECOILLESS RIFLE AMMUNITION. THE SHIPMENT ALSO INCLUDED OTHER UNSPECIFIED TYPES OF WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION (NFI).

3. ~~(S/NOFORN)~~ THE AIRPLANES DEPARTED FOR SAUDI ARABIA, FLEW ON TO THE PORT OF HOBYO [REDACTED] SOMALIA, AND THEN TO GAALKACYO [REDACTED] SOMALIA. UPON ARRIVING IN GAALKACYO, THE SHIPMENT WAS UNLOADED FROM THE AIRPLANES AND TRANSPORTED TO MOGADISHU, SOMALIA, VIA TRUCKS (NFI).
