SUBJECT: Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA) Compliance with Section 1228 of FY08 NDAA

- 1. In response to the requirement to provide documentation regarding lethal, non-lethal, and financial transfers to the Government of Iraq to comply with Section 1228 of the FY08 National Defense Authorization Act. With respect to the requirements under the Act for implementation of the registration and monitoring system, DSCA certifies that:
- a. DSCA and subject transfers through the Foreign Military Sales (FMS) are compliant with the requirement for the registration of serial numbers of all small arms to be provided to the Government of Iraq, or to other groups, organizations, citizens, or residents of Iraq. DSCA and FMS are also compliant with the requirement to maintain a detailed record of the origin, shipping, and the distribution of all defense articles transferred to Iraq.
- b. DSCA has ensured compliance with the requirements to have a program of end-use monitoring (EUM) of all lethal defense articles. Through the Golden Sentry End-Use Monitoring Program all relevant Section 1228 requirements are met.
- c. Procedures to comply with Section 1228 have been defined, documented and are in place. These include transfers of all defense articles provided through the Foreign Military Sales program.
