SUBJECT: Approval of the FY99 Air and Missile Defense Master Plan

1. The undersigned approve the FY99 Air and Missile Defense Master Plan (AMDMP).
2. The FY99 AMDMP is the Air Defense Artillery branch modernization plan to execute the air and missile defense mission on the battlefields of the next century. It provides a common azimuth to focus air and missile defense modernization for the needs of Army XXI through the Army After Next.
