CODE WORD, NICKNAME, AND EXERCISE TERM REPORT (SHORT TITLE--NICKA)

1. <u>Purpose</u>. This manual establishes standard administrative policy for the assignment and management of the Code Word, Nickname, and Exercise Term Report.

- 2. Gencellation. CJCSM 3150.29, 1 February 1996, is canceled.
- 3. Applicability. This manual applies to the Joint Staff, CINCs, Services, NSA, DSWA, DIA, DISA, NIMA, DIS, DLA, and other DOD agencies and is forwarded to the White House and OSD for information.
- 4. <u>Policy</u>. The Code Word, Nickname, and Exercise Term (NICKA) system is designed to fully automate the OSD requirement for maintenance of code words, nicknames, exercise terms, and reconnaissance nicknames data by the Joint Staff. NICKA maintains records of all reported code words and their status, all reconnaissance nicknames used at the Joint Reconnaissance Center, all exercise terms, and all currently authorized nicknames. The system validates code word and nickname usage with assigned agencies and ensures that authorized nicknames and code words are not duplicated. The NICKA transaction provides a way to register and maintain the currency of code words, nicknames, and exercise terms. NICKA currently resides in the Global Command and Control System, classified Top Secret (GCCS(TS)).

5. Definitions

- a. Code Word--A single word assigned a classified meaning by appropriate authority to ensure proper security concerning intentions and to safeguard information pertaining to actual, real-world military plans or operations classified CONFIDENTIAL or higher. A code word is placed in one of three categories:
- (1) Available--Allocated to using component. Available code words INDIVIDUALLY will be UNCLASSIFIED until placed in the active category.
 - (2) Active--Assigned a CLASSIFIED meaning and current.
- (3) Canceled--Formerly active but discontinued because of compromise, suspected compromise, cessation, or completion of the operation to which the code word pertained.
- b. Nickname--A combination of two separate unclassified words that is assigned an unclassified meaning and is employed only for unclassified administrative, morale, or public information purposes.
- c. Exercise Term--A nickname or code word, normally an unclassified nickname, used exclusively to designate a test, drill, or exercise. An exercise term is employed to prevent confusion between exercise directions and actual operations.

6. Responsibilities

- a. Data for NICKA processing will be submitted to the Joint Staff by the Chief of Staff, US Army; Chief of Naval Operations; Chief of Staff, US Air Force; Commandant of the Marine Corps; DOD agencies; commanders of unified commands; and certain other agencies. Table 1-1 (Enclosure C) lists those agencies authorized to submit data.
- b. Internal Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps requesting procedures will be prescribed by the Service headquarters.
- c. The Military Services, DOD agencies, and CINCS will route requests for NICKA registrations or revisions to the Command Systems Operations Division, J-3, Joint Staff, Room 2C869, the Pentagon, Washington, D.C. 20318-3000.

- d. Data will be submitted to the Joint Staff to:
 - (1) Register an active code word, nickname, or exercise term.
 - (2) Change data on a previously registered code word, nickname, or exercise term.
 - (3) Cancel a registered code word, nickname, or exercise term.
- e. On behalf of OUSDP, the Joint Staff is responsible for allocating code words or blocks of code words to DOD components. DOD components may request allocation of such code words as required and may reallocate available code words within their organization, in accordance with individual policies and procedures, subject to applicable rules set forth herein and in subsection 12-104, DOD 5200.1-R.
- f. The Joint Staff is responsible for assigning nickname and exercise term letter groups from Table 1-3 (Enclosure E) to DOD components.
- 7. Procedures. See Enclosure A.
- 8. Additional Copies of Manuals. Joint Staff directorates may obtain a limited number of copies of this manual from the Records and Information Research Branch, Room 2B917. The Services, CINCs, Defense agencies, and all other holders are authorized to reproduce, print, and stock additional copies to meet internal distribution requirements.
- 9. <u>Summary of Changes</u>. Administrative update to show that NICKA resides in the GCCS(TS). Miscellaneous allocations in the tables have changed.
- 10. <u>Information Requirements</u>. Reports required by this manual are exempt from normal reporting procedures in accordance with reference b.
- 11. Effective Date. This manual is effective upon receipt.

ENCLOSURE A

PROCEDURES

1. NICKA Data Base Access

- a. A Service, DOD agency, or unified command that has access to a Global Command and Control System, Classified Top Secret (GCCS(TS)), may update, retrieve on the terminal, or print NICKA records at any TS3 site. Procedures for online use of NICKA are contained in JDSSC Code Word, Nickname, and Exercise Term (NICKA) System Users Manual, CSM UM 171-89, 1 October 1989.
- b. If a GCCS(TS) terminal is not available, NICKA transactions can be submitted by letter or transmitted by AUTODIN to Joint Staff, J-3/CSOD. The letter or message should contain the data fields shown in the NICKA transaction sheet (Enclosure B) or the NICKA transaction sheet may be reproduced locally and submitted.
- 2. <u>Reporting</u>. A NICKA transaction will normally use routine precedence. Nickname and exercise term reporting will be suspended after declaration of worldwide DEFCON 3 or higher.
- 3. <u>Classification</u>. The originator of a NICKA transaction will assign the appropriate security classification to each transaction in accordance with the guidelines contained in paragraph 7 below.
- 4. <u>Cancellation</u>. Cancellation of a code word, nickname, or exercise term will be requested when the code word, nickname, or exercise term no longer servés a useful purpose or is obsolete. Nicknames and exercise terms will be déleted from the file 2 years after cancellation. Canceled code words will be automatically reclassified CONFIDENTIAL for a period of 2 years, after which the code word will become UNCLASSIFIED.

5. Code Words

- a. A code word is a single word selected from an assigned block listed in the NICKA file and assigned an appropriate classification. Code word block allocations are contained in Table 1-2 (Enclosure D).
 - b. A record of all code words will be maintained by the Joint Staff.

- c. Using components and the Directorate, Special Programs, OUSDP, will maintain records on code words within blocks assigned. The using component will account for available code words and maintain a record of each active code word. Upon being canceled, the using component will maintain the record for 2 years. After the 2 years, the record of each word may be disposed of in accordance with current practices and the code word returned to the available inventory.
- d. Using DOD components will verify active code words annually by 1 October. Verification will be accomplished by validating the data base in GCCS(TS) and certifying verification completion to the Joint Staff (subparagraph 5d(2)).
- (1) The first paragraph in the verification message or memorandum format will certify verification completion. The second paragraph will contain the organization's point of contact or system manager and a phone number.
- (2) Messages will be addressed to JOINT STAFF WASHINGTON DC//J-3/CSOD//. Memorandums will be addressed to the Joint Staff, J-3, Command Systems Operations Division, Washington, D.C. 20318-3000.
- (3) In the event that a using component does not have electronic access to the data base in GCCS (TS), a request for an active code word printout will be requested from J-3, CSOD, to facilitate annual code word verification.

6. Nicknames

- a. A nickname will consist of two separate words, the first of which must begin with the combination of letters of the alphabet allocated to the CINCS, the Military Services, and the directors of Defense agencies by the Director for Operations, Joint Staff, as listed in Table 1-3 (Enclosure E).
- b. Nicknames may be assigned to actual, real-world events; projects; movement of forces; or exercise activities involving elements of information of any classification category. However, the nickname, the description or meaning it represents, and the relationship of the nickname and its meaning must be UNCLASSIFIED. A nickname is an identifier and is not designed to achieve a security objective. (See also Chapter 8-103f., DOD 5200.1-R, reference a.)

- c. Nicknames improperly selected can be counterproductive. A nickname must be chosen with sufficient care to ensure that it does not:
- (1) Express a degree of bellicosity inconsistent with traditional American ideals or current foreign policy.
- (2) Convey connotations offensive to good taste or derogatory to a particular group, sect, or creed.
- (3) Convey connotations offensive to US allies or other Free World nations.
 - d. The following will not be used as nicknames:
- (1) Any two-word combination voice call sign found in JANAP 119.
- (2) Combination of words, including the words "project, exercise, or operation."
- (3) Words that may be used correctly either as a single word or as two words, such as "moonlight."
- (4) Exotic words, trite expressions, or well-known commercial trademarks.
- (5) Two-word combination including a code word as part of the combination.

7. Exercise Terms

- a. An exercise term is selected using the same criteria as for nicknames.
- b. Exercise terms may be assigned only to tests, drills, or exercises for the purpose of emphasizing that the event is a test, drill, or exercise and not an actual, real-world operation. The exercise term, the description or meaning it represents, and the relationship of the exercise term and its meaning is normally an unclassified nickname. A classified code word is designed to simulate actual use of DOD code words and must be employed using identical security procedures throughout the planning, preparation, and execution of the test, drill, or exercise to ensure realism.

c. Selection of exercise terms will follow the same guidance as contained in subparagraphs 6c and 6d above.

8. Classification and Downgrading Instructions

a. Code Words

- (1) During the development of a plan or the planning of an operation by the headquarters of the using component, the code word and its meaning will have the same classification. When dissemination of the plan to other DOD components or to subordinate echelons of the using component is required, the using component may downgrade the classification of code words below the classification assigned to their meanings in order to facilitate additional planning implementation and execution by other components or echelons. To facilitate this planning, code words may be downgraded to CONFIDENTIAL but must remain classified.
- (2) A code word that is replaced by another code word because of compromise, suspected compromise, or for any other reason will be canceled and classified CONFIDENTIAL for a period of 2 years while not in use.
- (3) When a plan or operation is discontinued or completed and is not replaced by a similar plan or operation but the meaning cannot be declassified, the code word assigned thereto will be canceled and classified CONFIDENTIAL for a period of 2 years or until the meaning is declassified, whichever is sooner. The code word will remain CONFIDENTIAL.
- , (4) In every case, whenever a code word is referred to in documents, the security classification of the code word will be placed in parentheses immediately following the code word; e.g., "Label (C)."
- (5) When the meaning of a code word no longer requires a classification, the using component will declassify the meaning and the code word and return the code word to the available inventory.
 - b. Nicknames. Nicknames will not be classified.
- c. Exercise Terms. In cases where a code word is used for an exercise, the provisions stated for code words in subparagraph 8a apply.

9. Security

- a. The meaning of a code word may be used in a message or other document together with the code word only when it is essential to do so.
- b. In handling correspondence pertaining to active code words, care will be used to avoid bringing the code words and their meanings together.
- c. Meanings of code words are not normally reported under the NICKA system. The authority (e.g., DOD/NSC/Military Service Office) that establishes the code word should be entered under the description.
- 10. <u>Deconfliction</u>. If a DOD component becomes aware of a conflict between a non-DOD official term and a DOD nickname, exercise term, or code word, it will endeavor to deconflict the NICKA data base.
