National Security Study Memorandum 105

SUBJECT: Addendum to NSSM 103

In connection with the papers being prepared in response to NSSM 103, it is also requested that a paper be prepared on the status of the U. S. response to the following Israeli requests for economic assistance:

1. \$50 million in supporting assistance.
2. \$85 million in PL 480 assistance.
3. Request for access to the proceeds of the German offset loan.
4. Assistance in desalting.
5. Request for additional El Al landing rights.
6. Request for special treatment on textiles.
7. Request to be treated as a lower income country for purposes of eligibility to compete for AID procurement.

This memorandum should state a proposed U. S. position on each of these issues with appropriate explanation and alternatives in any case where there are significant ones.

This memorandum should be coordinated by the NSCIG/NEA and forwarded to the NSC Senior Review Group by November 27.
